REQUIRED DOCUMENTS TO TAKE ROAD TEST

- 1. Valid Permit
- 2. License of the person bringing you. (They MUST be 21 years or older)
- 3. Valid Insurance card
- 4. Valid Registration Card
- 5. If under 18, Form DL-18OC (65-hour parent form)

** DL-180C must be notarized if parent does not come in**

DMV WILL NOT ACCEPT PHOTO COPIES OR FAXES

The DMV provides you with the following information with the intention that you will be aware of their expectations and that your driving test will be a memorable one.

a. Knowledge of Controls :

You will be tested on your ability to operate all the controls of your vehicle; head lights (high and low beams), turn signals, four-way flashers, brake lights, wipers, defrosters(front and rear), emergency brake, and horn. Please make sure you can locate and operate all of these controls.

b. Skill Maneuvers:

1) Parallel Park (8 feet X 24 feet) without striking cones, markers, or jumping over the curb.

C. Road Test:

Be able to operate your vehicle through traffic, roadways, and intersection, all in a safe and professional manner as per Publication 95. (Drivers Manual) If you have any questions about your driving test, Please ask the Examiner before you start the test.
